



The Official Sea Scout Uniform

The Official Sea Scout Uniform is worn by all youth and adult Ship members.

More details can be found in the Sea Scout Manual.

Sea Scout Uniform Components



- Navy Blue ball cap, No. 618623; with SEA SCOUTS and the Sea Scout logo embroidered in white.
- Dark Navy Blue shirt; similar to Dickies Nos. 1574DN and FS574DN, color DN, dark navy.
- · Dark Navy Blue t-shirt.
- Dark Navy Blue pants; similar to Dickies Nos. 874DN and 774DN, color DN, dark navy.
- Black web belt and buckle with Sea Scout logo, No. 618624.
- Black plain-toe shoes and black socks. Or, activity footwear such as boat shoes, hiking boots, or athletic shoes.
- Optional Neckerchiefs (unit option)
 Youth and Adults may wear No.618625; black triangular design (unit option).
 The "tar flap" design, No. 618626, is reserved for youth only (unit option)









Sea Scout Uniform Specifics and Tips

- "Unit option" means that all the members of a Ship (unit) wear the optional item; based upon a unit decision.
- Sea Scout uniforms are traditionally worn with limited insignia to help retain a sharp appearance.
- Matching shorts, or cargo shorts, may be worn.
- Remove all manufacturer's labels and marks that show on the outside of the garment.

Sea Scout Uniform Insignia Placement

(Required insignia are marked with an asterisk*.)

Wearer's Right Side

Sleeve

- American Flag*, No. 103
- Universal Sea Scout emblem*
 No. 641601; or custom ship emblem*
- Journey to Excellence
- National Flagship Award or National Flagship Fleet Award is worn in place of the JTE

Over Pocket

- Sea Badge insignia, No. 4097
- Nametag, No. 639828 (black with white lettering)
- Sea Scouts BSA strip*, No. 641602

Pocket Flap

• Order of the Arrow lodge flap

Pocket

 The Long Cruise Badge and arcs may be worn centered on the right pocket, if there isn't room on the left sleeve

Wearer's Left Side

Sleeve

- Council strip*
- Unit number*
- · Round badge of office
- Trained strip, No. 639675, or SEAL sleeve emblem, No. 655800
- Long Cruise Badge No. 648391 and Arcs No. 648393 (red) and No. 648392 (white); the arcs encircle the badge

Over Pocket

- World Crest*, No. 143
- SEAL double-dolphin insignia
- Knots (up to six)
- BSA-authorized suspended medals (suggested for formal events)

Pocket Flap

• None
