There are no provisions to accommodate personnel or guests with food allergies or special dietary restrictions; nor may personnel or guests bring their own food. The medical facilities aboard CGC EAGLE are very limited; a severe allergic reaction while at sea would be life threatening for the patient and diversion to shore-side medical resources would disrupt the ship's training mission.

In addition to transportation, candidates will need to plan to pay for their meals aboard CGC EAGLE (about \$85) and clothing items (about \$75).
